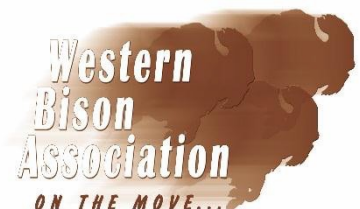

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ENTRY DEADLINE: November 15 or when capacity has been reached. An entry packet, including ear tags, will be sent to each consignor.

ENTRY LIMITS: Consignors will be limited to two (2) entries per class in the Show-and-Sale, and Show-Only classes. No limits on Production Class animal.

ENTRY FEES: Show and Sale: \$50 per head. Show Only: \$500 per head. Production Class: NO CHARGE. Entry fees must be sent with the entry forms. Late entries must contact Bob Lawson at (408)690-5559 for availability

LOAD IN/OUT: ALL animals are to arrive beginning on Tuesday, November 30th and must be in no later than Thursday, December 2nd before 12 noon. In case of emergency, call Bob Lawson at (408)690-5559 or Jake Weirich at (720)209-7519. Load-out immediately following the sale on December 4th when the paperwork and all payments are completed. Load-out will continue until dark. Load-out on Sunday, December 5th until 1 PM. Trailers can be parked at the Golden Spike Event Center.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES: All animals will require a complete health certificate issued and signed by a licensed veterinarian from your State. **Separate Health Certificates** are required for **EACH** animal. Utah requires an entry permit number for each consignor entering from another State that your veterinarian obtains by calling 801-538-7164. **Health Requirements are as follows:**

1. Negative Tuberculosis test (caudal fold), **ALL ANIMALS**, within 30 days of December 5th, 2021.
2. Negative Brucellosis test, **ALL ANIMALS**, within 30 days of December 5th, 2021, except female calves under 12 months of age, which must be OCV (Official Calftooth Vaccinates).
3. Negative Trichomoniasis test on all male animals 9 months and older, within 30 days of December 5th, 2021. PCR TEST only. Method must be notated on the health certificate. Trich ear tag must be in right ear and **covered with duct tape**.
4. All females must be OCV for brucellosis. Show-tag numbers, metal tag numbers, and BV tattoo numbers must correctly coincide on the health certificate.
5. **ALL ANIMALS** must be treated with injectable Ivermectin plus wormer within 30 days of December 5th, 2021, which must be noted on the health certificate.
6. Your veterinarian must verify the ages of all the animals. All calves and yearlings must have all baby teeth. All two-year-olds shall have no more than four fully erupted incisors. If a fifth baby tooth is missing, the animal will be disqualified from the class.
7. **Three (3)** copies of the health certificate must be furnished, all with the original health certificate.
8. **ANIMALS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO UNLOAD IF THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT MET.**

DEFINITIONS: Show-and-Sale animals and Show-Only animals will be judged, and awards presented in the respective classes. Production Class animals will not be judged.

Liability Waiver

- A) The consignor assumes all responsibilities in regard to the above mentioned terms and conditions of this show and sale. The Western Bison Association acts only as an agent and will assume NO responsibility in the event of injury or death to any animal or any discrepancy between the buyer and the consignor. Consignor agrees to indemnify and hold the Western Bison Association and its officers, members, directors, employees or agents harmless from and against any lawsuits, claims, action or causes of action arising out of, or in connection with, any errors or omissions of Consignor, its agents, representatives or employees, with respect to Consignor's duties and responsibilities set forth in this Agreement. This obligation by Consignor includes, but is not limited to, the cost of defense, payment of any judgments and payment of any expenses and for attorney's fees and other costs which may be incurred.
- B) In accordance with Western Bison Association regulations, a sifting committee may be appointed to view the animals entered and any animal deemed to be without merit as would entitle them to exhibit, the sale chairman may require them to be removed from the Golden Spike grounds. Judges reserve the right to disqualify any animal from show or sale if, in their opinion, there is reason. The reasons include, but are not limited to, the following: animal appears to be diseased, injured, or in poor condition.
- C) If on arrival or during its stay in the yards, an animal appears to be unhealthy, either the Western Bison Association Show and Sale Committee or the Western Bison Association Show and Sale Chairman reserves the right to have that animal examined by a licensed Utah veterinarian. If any animal is determined to be unhealthy by the veterinarian, that animal shall be removed from the show and sale. Costs of examination shall be borne by the Western Bison Association if the animal is deemed healthy or borne by the Consignor if the animal is deemed unhealthy.

I (we) affirm the non-use of growth stimulants or steroids. I (we) agree to testing of consigned animals during the Wild West Buffalo Stampede Show and Sale period (the week of the sale). I (We) agree that a violation of this rule could, subject to action by the WBA Board, lead to permanent banishment from both the Wild West Buffalo Stampede Show and Sale, and the WBA. I (we) affirm that our animal(s) have not been treated for any health or medical condition in the previous 30 days, other than required vaccinations and worming treatments, or will provide a documented description of any treatment within the 30 day period.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS *(continued from other side)*

The State of Utah will not allow you to have more than one animal on a health certificate.

BREEDING BULLS SEMEN TESTING: Semen testing is required on the Show-and-Sale and Show-Only animals entered in the Yearling Bull and Two-Year-Old Bull classes. **Production Class** yearling bulls, two-year-old bulls and three-year-old bulls will NOT be required to be semen tested, but it is highly recommended that you do so in order to get the highest possible price for your animals.

PREGNANCY TESTING: A positive pregnancy test result is required on Show-and-Sale and Show-Only females entered in the Two- Year-Old Bred Heifer and the 3-4-Year-Old Bred Cow classes. A negative pregnancy test is required on all Show-and-Sale and Show-Only Yearling Heifers. Palpation, ultrasound, or biotracking are acceptable tests. Have your veterinarian notate test results on the health certificate or attach the lab pregnancy test sheets. Production Class yearlings and two-year-olds are NOT required to be pregnancy tested.

EAR TAGS: ALLFLEX show and sale ear tags will be assigned and provided. ALL females must have OCV brucellosis vaccination tags. ALL males must have metal brucellosis test tags. WBA Show and Sale tags MUST be applied to the animal's LEFT EAR prior to arrival in Ogden. North America Bison Registry (NABR) and any permanent State trichomoniasis tags may remain on the animal. **ALLOTHERRANCHEARTAGSMUSTBEREMOVED.**

Two-Year-Old Bull tags are yellow, numbers 201-230
Two-Year-Old Bred Heifer tags are white, numbers 251-280

Production Class ANIMALS

Bull Calf tags are orange, numbers 31-50
Heifer Calf tags are blue, numbers 81-99
Yearling Bull tags are orange, numbers 131-150 Yearling
Heifer tags are blue, numbers 181-199
Two-Year-Old Bull tags are orange, numbers 231-250
Two-Year-Old Heifer tags are blue, numbers 281-299
Three-Year-Old Bull tags are orange, numbers 331-350

HORNS: Horned and dehorned animals will be allowed. Severe bleeders from broken horns may not be allowed in the sale area, at the discretion of the Show and Sale chairman. The decision of the Show and Sale chairman is final.

COMMISSION: A **9% commission** will be deducted from the sale price of each SHOW animal sold at auction. A **6% commission** will be deducted from the sale price of each PRODUCTION animal sold at auction.

QUALITY ANIMALS: It is strongly advised by the WBA Show and Sale Committee that all consignors bring good quality animals to the event. Any animal deemed unfit, due to injury, mistreatment or poor health, may be eliminated or disqualified from the show and sale at the discretion of the Show and Sale chairman. No cow/calf pairs will be allowed.

PAYMENTS IN AND OUT: Animals that are not pre-entered with entry fees paid in full will not be unloaded. All money due must be paid prior to load out. PLEASE NOTE: Anyone who "tests the waters" and brings and buys their animals back must pay in cash the full price of the animal(s) prior to their being released. The Western Bison Association will not accept commission-only funds. Anyone giving Western Bison Association a "hot" or insufficient-funds check will be banned from future show and sales of the Western Bison Association. Any "hot" checks will be turned over to the State of origin for criminal prosecution. All consignor checks will be mailed after receipts have cleared the bank, usually within ten days.

LIABILITY: The consignor assumes all responsibility in regards to, but not limited to, all the terms and conditions of this show and sale. The WBA acts only as agents and will assume no responsibility in the event of injury or death to any animal or for any discrepancy between buyer and seller.

NO MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED: Consignors are **NOT** required to be members of the Western Bison Association in order to enter animals in the Wild West Buffalo Stampede Show and Sale.

Competition Guidelines:

Entry and registration free – all juniors ages 9 thru 19 are invited to participate. Junior membership in Western Bison Association, 4-H or FFA is not required.

- Top scoring individual will be awarded a **\$1,000.00 scholarship** to a school of higher education of their choice.
- Second top scoring individual will be awarded **\$500.00 scholarship**.
- Third top scoring individual will be awarded **\$300.00 scholarship**.
- Take home awards will be presented to the top 3 scoring individuals and the top 3 scoring teams made up of 3 to 4 participants.
- The judging format will be similar to that used by the 4-H and FFA. All participants will judge 3 classes of bison; these bison will already be at the Golden Spike Event Center in preparation for the Western Bison Association's "Wild West Buffalo Stampede Show & Sale".
