

# Marland Ray Memorial Junior Judging Scholarship Competition Set for Friday, Dec. 1

## Competition Guidelines:

**\$1800 IN SCHOLARSHIPS!** Entry and registration free – all juniors ages 9 thru 19 are invited to participate. Junior membership in Western Bison Association, 4-H or FFA is not required.

- Top scoring individual will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship to a school of higher education of their choice.
- Second top scoring individual will be awarded \$500 scholarship.
- Third top scoring individual will be awarded \$300 scholarship.
- Take home awards will be presented to the top three scoring individuals and the top three scoring teams made up of three to four participants.
- The judging format will be similar to that used by the 4-H and FFA. All participants will judge three classes of bison; these bison will already be at The River View Ranch location in preparation for the Western Bison Association's Wild West Buffalo Stampede Show & Sale.
